Ms Marsic started work in the NSW Public Service in 1997 at the Judicial Commission of NSW. Between 1998 and 2008 Ms

Marsic was a legal officer with the NSWPF. In that time she was the lead legal advisor on the development and implementation of the Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Act 2000. She spent the next ten years in various roles within the Justice Cluster including with the Standing Committee of Attorneys-General, NSW Rural Fire Service and Crown Solicitor's office. In 2018, Ms Marsic rejoined the NSW Police Force as the Director of Crime Disruption & Special Inquiries Law before being appointed as the NSWPF General Counsel in 2021.
